

NCIC Revises 2014 Maximum Compensation Rate

The maximum weekly benefit applicable to all injuries and claims arising on or after January 1, 2014, is now \$904.00. Employers and carriers who have paid disability compensation at the rate of \$912.00 for claims arising on or after January 1, 2014, shall be entitled to a credit for related overpayments.
